### Business E-mail Compromise

According to some latest data published by a US based company, Abnormal Security, the rise in report working has made employees more susceptible to BEC attacks. Recently the data has picked up a shift from BEC criminal operators, who originally targeted Executives, to now switching their focus to Finance staff. BEC is so prevalent, it makes up nearly one-in-four cyber insurance claims according to a 2018 AIG report, which focuses on Europe, the Middle East, and Asia (EMEA).

### So what is Business E-mail Compromise?

Business Email Compromise (BEC) is a form of phishing attack. BEC attacks are crafted to appeal to specific individuals and can be even harder to detect than typical phishing emails. The attackers attempt to defraud the company, its customers, partners, and/or employees into sending money or sensitive data to the attacker's account.

In a BEC scam, criminals send an email message that appears to come from a known source making a legitimate request, like in these examples:

- A vendor your company regularly deals with sends an invoice with an updated mailing address.
- A company CEO asks her assistant to purchase dozens of gift cards to send out as employee rewards. She asks for the serial numbers so she can email them out right away.
- A homebuyer receives a message from his title company with instructions on how to transfer his down payment.

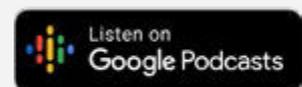
